


of home pages had detected WCAG 2 failures.



- group of buttons coded as list





- great use of color
- has focus states
- keyboard accessible audio player that indicates where in the text is being read
- well organized internal pages with lots of text and data and multiple ways to consume the content





- informational tabs that are unique (markup not quite screen reader accessible but has potential)
- great use of colors, icons, images, and varied layouts
- a lot of opportunity here to bring the inner pages in line with the home page





- uses brand elements in various ways: shapes, illustrations, color, etc

- respects ad blockers without extra message
- link for audio player keyboard shortcuts
- additional navigation icons appear when tabbing
- thoughtful use of color, buttons, and icons
- they have a text-only version of their site
